

COVID VACCINE ROLLOUT PHASE 1B- INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION OF INTEREST

This page lays out up to date information about the current phase of the COVID vaccine (Astra Zeneca) rollout.

Rye Family Clinic is one of the clinics in the initial cohort of the Phase 1B rollout of the COVID vaccine commencing 22 March 2021. We have already ordered our first lot of vaccines and will hopefully be receiving our first supplies by week ending 19 March. We will be receiving a limited supply of vaccines on a weekly basis and will endeavour to start vaccinating as soon as practicable. We will be requesting those eligible to receive the vaccine in the first phase to start registering via phone after **checking their eligibility** at:
